 **Communications & Safety Support**

T.A.R.A. will provide radio-based communication and safety support throughout the event. Our team will work closely with event leadership and public safety officials.

### Radio Operations

Primary Operating Frequency:

- Channel 1 (Simplex 58) – For all event-related communications

Secondary Frequency for Non-Event Traffic:

- Channel 2 (Simplex 52) – All personal or non-event traffic must shift here

Monitoring Team on Channel 1 & FRS Channel 8:

- Micah KN6VUT (Communications Lead)
- Net Control
- John D
- Joe (*Doing Joe Stuff*) Jacobson

FRS Monitoring:

Non-licensed FRS radios will be monitored by Net Control, Micah, and designated operators.

### Incident Reporting Protocol

Any issues or concerns should be relayed via:

- Radio to Micah, or if not available John via Net Control

Micah or John will coordinate the relay of information between amateur and FRS channels to ensure swift resolution.

### FCC Compliance Reminder

All licensed operators must follow FCC station identification rules per 47 CFR § 97.119:

- Transmit your callsign with each communication
- And at least every 10 minutes during **ongoing** transmissions
- **No need to ID if you are not actively transmitting**
