W6GRA Go Box Neil Record, W6GRA

It's a portable, battery powered, dual band "Emergency" radio that I assembled. And it actually works!

I wanted to put together an emergency, battery powered dual band radio that I could grab and go out the door with. Everything, except the antenna, fits inside the box. I had to install some padding around the battery, and do some other cutting and fitting to get everything in the box. The Diamond antenna is really too big for the intended purpose, but it's what I had laying around so that's what I used. That's what the other plastic tube is for. A shorter antenna would be easier to deal with.





Here's what I've got:

- B-Tech UV-25X2 dual band mini mobile radio, 10W-25W power.
- Motorcycle battery, I forget what brand.
- Short jumper with battery clamps at one end, cigarette lighter on the other end.
- Diamond NR770 antenna, with Diamond mag mount base (Sold separately).
- Volt meter to measure current level in battery.
- Plastic case to house everything, about the size of a 50 caliber ammo can.

• Telescoping plastic case to hold the antenna. (I taped it together with duct tape).

So, obviously you open the box, assemble the parts, connect the radio to the battery, and start transmitting. I've used the radio twice just to make sure it works. Just need to make sure the battery is always charged up and ready to go.
