## **Amateur Radio for the New Ham** How do you find someone to talk to?

- Local Repeaters
  - Check <u>AC6EE.org</u> or the Newsletter for list of repeaters
  - Call and ask for a radio check "W6QPA calling for a radio check"
  - Call and say "Monitoring" or "Listening" "W6QPA, Monitoring"
- Linked Repeaters
  - Try either KERN, WIN, ARRG linked repeaters
    - Cover wide areas and has many more hams potentially available
- DMR, D-Star, Fusion Repeaters
  - For example D-Star Reflector REF001C is a worldwide "Chat room"

### **Amateur Radio for the New Ham** What else is there beside talking through an FM repeater?

- Ten Meter SSB Phone
- APRS digital
  - Not just a tracking system. Has messaging capabilities
- Winlink email
- SSB Phone
- Explore Propagation modes
  - Tropo Scatter and Refraction
  - Sporadic-E layer propagation
  - Aurora
  - Meteor Scatter
  - Earth-Moon-Earth (aka Moon Bounce)

Current Solar Cycle supports long range QSO — Will (WA6LDQ) worked 8,500+ miles from his car
